DEFINITIONS

Race/Ethnicity: Students should be counted in the category of which they are most characteristic.

Asian – identifies as having origins in Far East, Southeast Asia or Indian Sub-continent: (Cambodia, China, India, Japan, Korea, Malaysia, Pakistan, Philippines, Thailand, Vietnam, etc.)

American Indian/Native Alaskan – identifies as one of the two classifications of natives Americans

Black/African American – identifies as black whether from US, Africa or other part of the world

Hispanic – identifies as of Hispanic origin

Native Hawaiian/Other Pacific Islander – includes native Hawaiians living anywhere in the US (but not non-Hawaiian residents of Hawaii); also includes other Pacific Islands : Guam, Samoa, Fiji, Micronesia, Polynesia

White – Caucasian from any part of the world (including Middle East) that does not identify as one of the other groups. The US Census does not classify Muslim/Arab as a racial category; it is a religious category.

Multi-racial – person belongs to more than one racial group
